



#### 1. Can teams have fewer than 5 members or more than 5?

Yes, teams can have a minimum of 3 members and a maximum of 5, including yourself. Ensure that your team accumulates the required number of Dragons to qualify.

### 2. Can my team include members from other countries?

Yes, you can include individuals from any country where Sanki operates.

### 3. Can I join multiple teams?

No, you may only be a part of one team.

### 4. Can I be the captain of multiple teams?

No, you can only serve as captain of one team, consisting of 3 to 5 members including yourself.

### 5. Can my team have multiple Diamonds or other high ranks?

No, you can have a maximum of 1 Diamond and 1 Platinum.

### 6. What is a Dragon?

A Dragon measures your progress toward achieving your goals. Each Dragon is worth 500 points\*.

#### **EXAMPLE**

### 7. Does the captain need to have a leadership rank?

NO, the captain is selected by team consensus and does not need a specific leadership rank.

#### 7.1. Can I switch teams?

No, you can only be part of one team throughout the contest period.

### 8. What happens if a team member fails to meet their individual and team goals?

The team may replace up to 2 members during the qualification period. However:

- Each substitution incurs a penalty of 50% of the points accumulated by the departing member.
- The departing member cannot join another team but can participate as an individual starting from zero.
- The new team member must not have been part of another registered team and will start with zero Dragons upon joining.





# 9. If I am part of a team but not in the captain's country, which Bootcamp should I attend?

Attend the Bootcamp in the country where you are registered or where you currently reside.

### 10. Can I register my team at any time?

Yes, you can register your team starting Tuesday, July 9, the launch date of the competition. Remember, the sooner you register, the sooner you start collecting Dragons.

# 11. Can team members be registered in different cycles during the qualification period?

No, all team members must be registered together in one single process through the registration link:

# 12. Will my team be disqualified if one or more members do not reach the minimum 1,000 individual points?

No, as long as the team meets the overall group goal, you can decide by mutual agreement whether the underperforming member will be included in the prize.

### 13. Can I change team members during the qualification period?

Yes, you can make up to 2 changes, following the rules outlined in question #8.

### 14. Can I change the team captain?

No, once chosen, the captain cannot be changed.

### 15. Can I participate alone, without a team?

Yes, you can participate individually. You must achieve 7 Dragons (3,500 points) at the Sanki Longevity Bootcamp and meet the total Dragon requirements for Japan. However, being part of a team can enhance your chances of success.

# 16. If a team member earns 40 Dragons (20,000 individual points) before the competition ends, does that mean they win the trip to Japan?

No, the trip is awarded based on the team's overall performance and achieving the group goal.

### 17. Can the Bootcamp prize be transferred if a winning team member does not want to attend?

No, the Bootcamp prize is non-transferable.

#### 18. Do my team members have to be direct enrollments?

No, they can be part of your network, whether upline or downline.

# 19. Can I include someone from my network who no longer has a sponsor?

Yes, as long as they are within your network.

### 20. Can a new team join after the competition has started?

Yes, but keep in mind that registering earlier gives your team more time to collect the required Dragons.

### 21. If my team doesn't meet the scores, can I join another team?

No, if you leave your current team, you will have to start over as an individual without carrying over any accumulated points.

### 22. Can I have uplines in my team?

Yes, you can include uplines from your network.

### 23. Can I bring a companion on the trip?

No, this trip is exclusively for Distributors who achieve their goals.

### 24. What if a team member is in Peru where the points system differs from other countries?

The points and Dragon accumulation system is uniform across all countries. Both direct registrations and TSPs (your own and your customers' purchases) contribute to your total.
